UYMHA Partnership Overview

- The structure of Upper York Minor Hockey Association is built on an equal partnership between Georgina and East Gwillimbury. Executive members will be required to sit on both boards. Upper York is not a stand-alone association.
- The Upper York Minor Hockey Board currently consists of 4 members from East Gwillimbury and 4 members from Georgina; all with an equal vote.
- Upper York Minor Hockey has 4 paid employees and is a registered not-forprofit organization.
- Georgina and East Gwillimbury Minor Hockey Associations each provided Upper York Minor Hockey with a \$20,000.00 interest free loan in order get the new association moving. This loan is being paid back over the next two years.

Formalizing the UYMHA Partnership

- Hosted Town Halls/Information Session in EG and in Georgina to share information on the pilot ahead of the realignment vote.
- On November 12th, both EGMHA and GMHA members voted to make the realignment of the Rep programs permanent:
 - East Gwillimbury 82% in favour
 - Georgina 88% in favour
- The Upper York Executive Board has finalized a new set of by-laws and policies which have been approved by OMHA legal and are posted on our website for your review.





Budgets

- A new budget policy has been issued by the association.
- Sponsorship funds collected by teams should be considered as "team proceeds" with the money being allocated equally among all players. Sponsorship donations should not be used for personal payments to cover an individual player's costs.
- Team opening budget plan must be saved on team shared drives no later than June 30th with read access provided to all parents/guardians
 - The budget should be reconciled to the team's bank account monthly with updated information included on the team shared drive for parent access.
- Each team will be required to carry a contingency fund equal to 5% of their total expenses. This fund will be released for spending by the treasurer following the Dec 1st mid-season review
- A mid-season review will be conducted on **Dec 1**st by the UYMHA treasurer(s). Team contingency funds will not be released for spending until the treasurer's mid-season review is completed

2025/26 Regular Season

- U8 and U9 MD Teams have joined UYMHA, will have two teams in each age group (Tier 1 and Tier 2)
- UYMHA, EGMHA, GMHA Teams are NO longer permitted to run non rostered participant events on association provided ice. This is Hockey Canada and OHF rule change in 2025/26.
- Month of September teams will be assigned practices based on ice availability.
- Regular Season begins October 1, 2025, and all teams will play meaningful hockey until March 1, 2025. ~ 26 game season (Not guaranteed to be balanced)
- YSMHL is implementing North/West and South/East divisions for age groups with a 10 or more teams in the division
 - Teams will play against every team in the opposite division once, remaining regular season games to be played within their division only.
- Looking to expand the Upper York Executive Board to 10 voting members to include Co-Treasurer Positions


